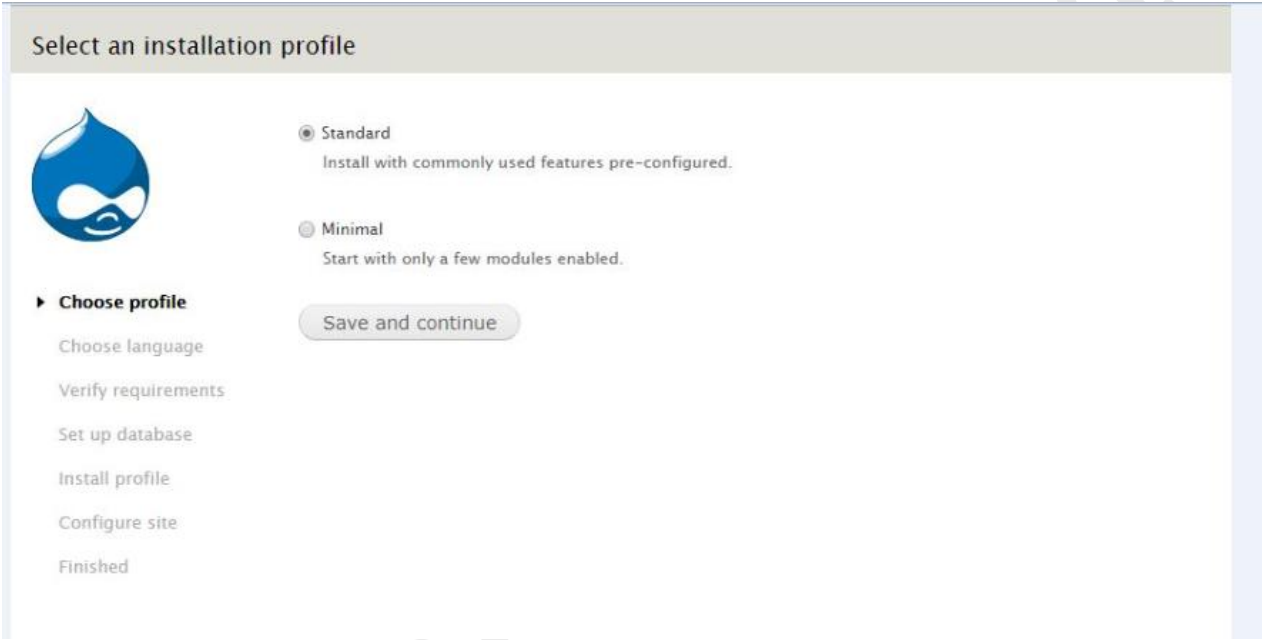


## Usage / Deployment Instruction

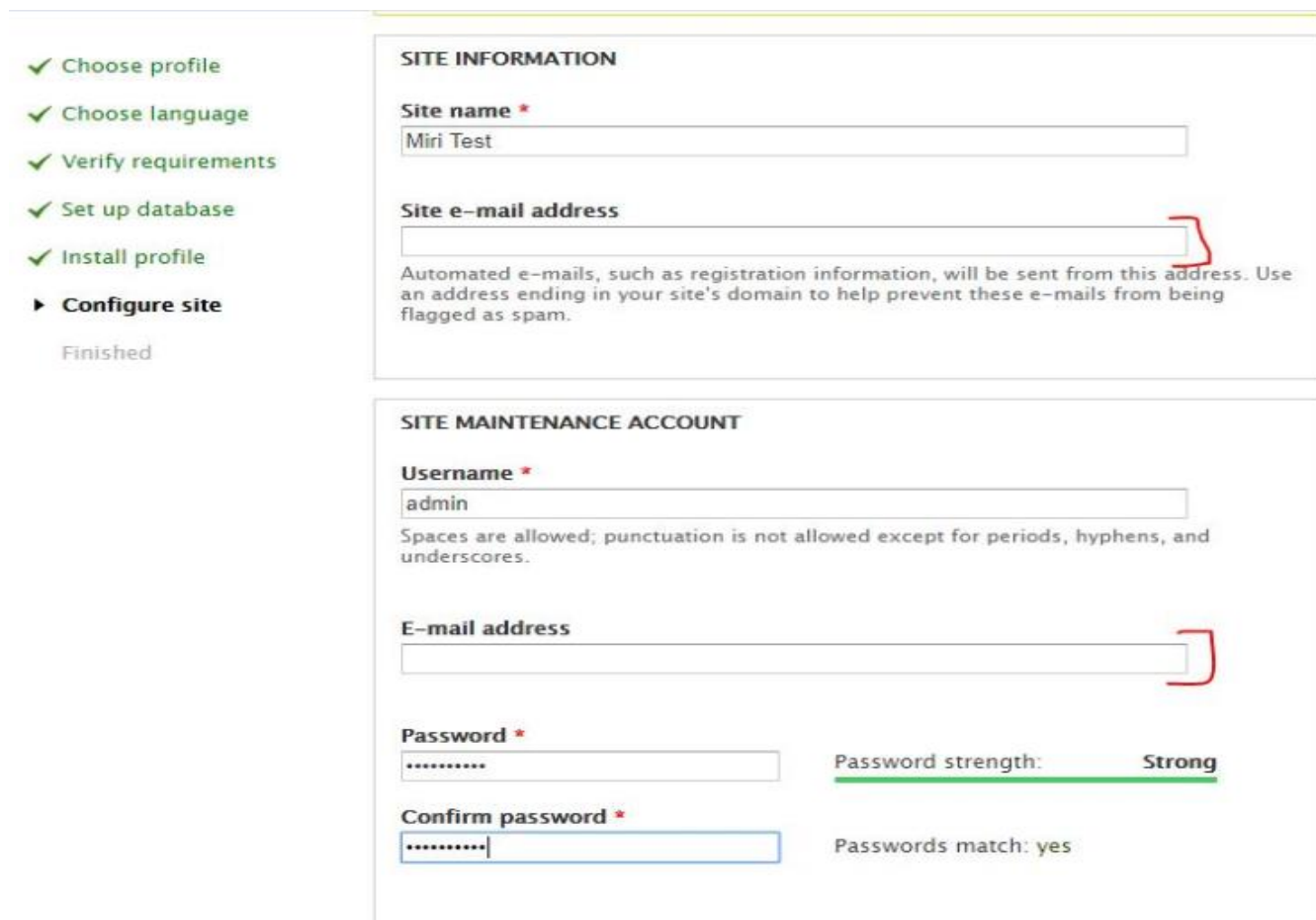
